## Классификация Э. Эйкштедта

Немецкий антрополог Э. Эйкштедт (1934) ввел для обозначения рас однообразную номенклатуру, составленную из названия характерной для расы этнической группы и окончания «иды». Это условное окончание без изменения применяется для обозначения как больших рас, так и меньших по объему подразделений — европиды, балтиды, динариды.

Эйкштедт признал три направления расовой дифференциации, но учел различия сочетаний признаков, степень их выраженности и установил в каждом направлении четыре подразделения:

основной «круг рас», включающий от четырех до девяти разновидностей в пределах главного ареала;

«боковую» расу, отделившуюся, по-видимому, до формирования основного круга форм;

«переходную», или промежуточную, расу, соединяющую отличия разных основных групп;

«своеобразную», или «уклоняющуюся», форму.

Точного общего определения выделенным таксонам автор не дал. Схема Эйкштедта включает три ствола, каждый с четырьмя достаточно обособленными ветвями:





Common in the French, Italians, Swiss, South Germanics and many other Europeans.

### Description:

Collective term for the Western Turanid variants, living in Eastern Europe and Turkey. This type is not very common, but still significant. The Turanid Hungarian population was described as the Alfoeldi type. Probably a result of the migrations of ancient Magyars, Huns, Tatars to Europe and Turkey. Greater amounts of European admixture distinguish West Turanids from Pamirids who are typical for the Tajik population and the Aralids of Central Asia.

### Body:

Medium height, Ectomorph to Endomorph

### Status:

A significant element in Turkey, Hungary, Balkan to South Ukraine. The type is relatively rare in Europe and only found in significant concentrations in some areas of Anatolia.
